It was a dish belonging in a Parisian travel brochure – tempting travellers with iconic indulgences from the most romantic city in the world – but, fortunately, we found it in a busy Fremantle café last Sunday afternoon.

Paris Crepes Café has only been open a few months but has already established a popular local following.

As my friend and I looked over the impressive menu featuring a range of mouth-watering delights, we realised it would be near impossible to decide.

The second I settled on the pineapple, brown sugar and rum-raisin ice cream filling, my eye caught sight of a nearby table tucking into the cinnamon baked apple crepe and I was back at square one.

My savoury-minded friend was equally overwhelmed having to choose between a melted cheese, French sausage and garlic potato crepe and creamy goats' cheese and chive.

In the end, we enlisted owner and experienced chef Didier Crévecoeur to choose for us, and I was so glad we did.

Stuffed with ribbons of smoked salmon and melted cheese, our savoury crepe exploded with flavour from diced tomatoes, fresh parsley and a salty kick of capers.

It was a joy to break through the crisp outer shell and explore the rainbow of tasty fillings.
